## PE and Sport Premium Spend 2023/24

The PE and Sport Premium is designed to help primary schools improve the quality of their PE lessons and sporting activities offered to each of their pupils. In 2023-24 we received a grant of £18,470.

After four consecutive years of achieving the Gold Award for the School Games Mark, the school were successful in winning the Platinum Award in 2023/24.

Our expenditure for the school year was £23,866.
